Discipline

In this classroom we learn from our mistakes through natural consequences for the most part.

For example on Fridays if all their work is handed in and they are on track with their reading goal they get free choice Friday for the first twenty minutes of the day. Didn't finish something? What to Expect in 3rd Grade

We do a lot of learning in third grade and I believe in working hard to play hard. Kids will only have homework if they do not finish their work during the day with exception of Tuesday nights when they will bring home their Big Reader to read a short story to someone of their choice. They have a comprehension test on this story each week on Fridays.

Spelling

We take our tests on THURSDAYS. If they do poorly I will retest them on the words they missed on Friday. On 4 day weeks we do not do retests and take the test on the last day of the week.

AR Reading

Your student will have an AR goal each 9 weeks. They should read for 20 minutes each night when possible. Students who double their AR goal are treated to lunch by me at the end of the 9 weeks.
